Re: Year 13 examination results day Thursday 13th August

As we move towards the end of summer term, we have to plan a safe way by which we can share your child's examination results this August. With the on-going situation, this will be different to what has taken place in previous years and will be in line with current social distancing expectations.

This summer, Year 13 students will still be able to come onto school site to collect their results in person. To accommodate this each pupil will be given **an appointment time**. These times will be sent out via parentmail on Friday 10th and Monday 13th July and must be adhered to. Any student who arrives before or after their allotted time will not be allowed into school. This will allow us to keep our students and staff safe. There will be a one way system in place to ensure social distancing. The only entrance will be from Woodland Road and the designated exit will be via our main car park. These will be clearly sign posted. Staff acting as stewards will be in high visibility uniform to direct pupils and ensure they do not congregate at the exit or entry points in line with health and safety guidelines
