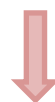

Apply



- During the application we will ask for your **Predicted Grades**.
 - Fill in this part of the form as accurately as you can using your progress grades or recent assignment marks.
 - Predicted grades will not matter when you come to enrol as we will then look at your actual grades.
- Your offer - Predicted grades allow us to understand which course and level we can offer you at the time of application. Your course offer will be conditional on you achieving specific grades at GCSE. When you accept your offer, you have reserved your place at Coleg Gwent.
- When you come to enrol, we will look at your actual grades and if these aren't what you expected we will be able to offer you an alternative course that will lead to your chosen career path. If you wish to change your course at enrolment, there will be staff available for you to talk through all your options.
